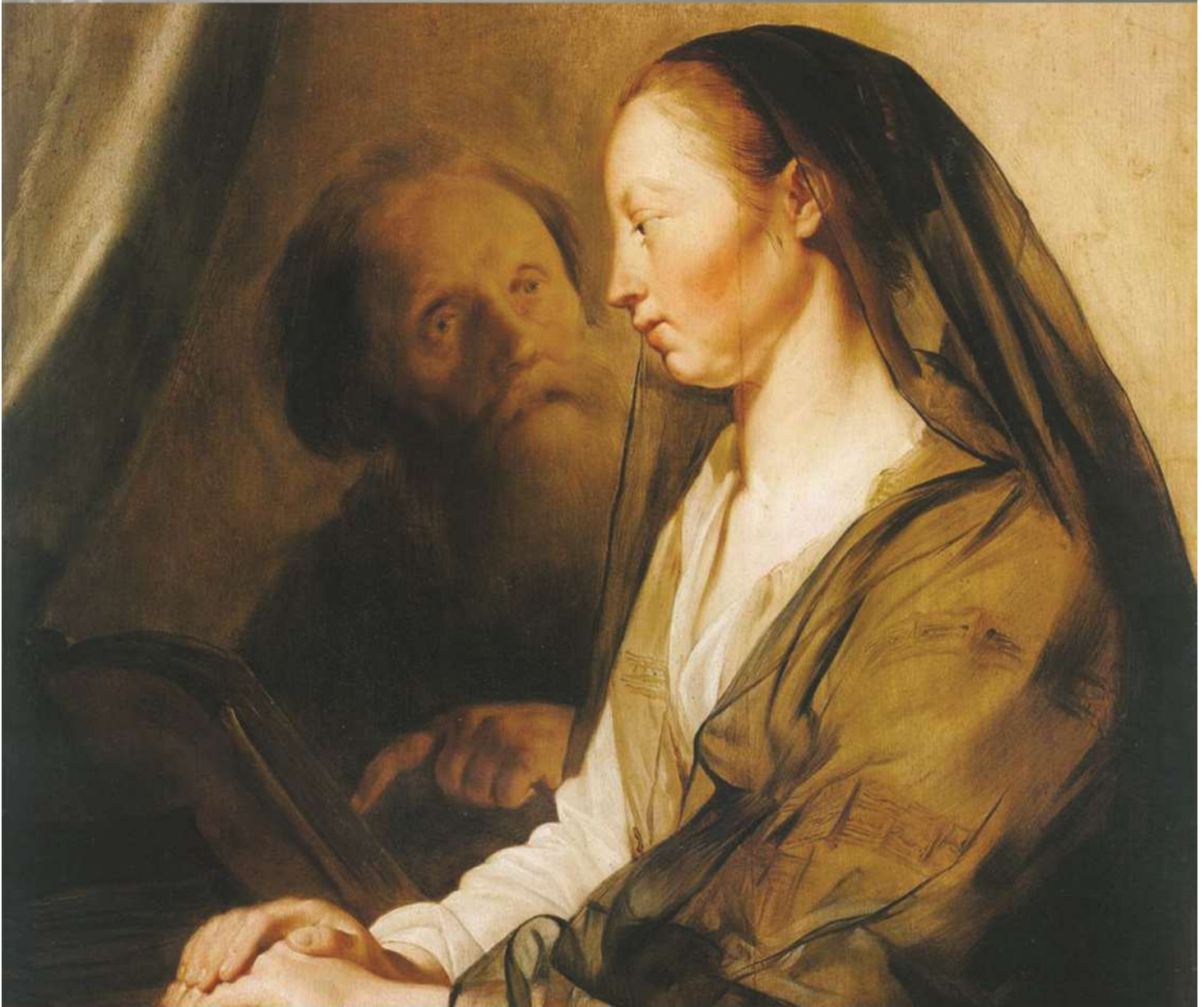

SUNDAY CONFESSIONS DISCONTINUED

As you know, the Mass is the "source and summit of our faith" for from the Mass we receive the Most Holy Eucharist, body, blood, soul and divinity.

In the short time available between the 11:00AM Mass and the 1:00PM Mass, there simply is not adequate time for people to make a good confession and for the priest to properly listen to them and offer absolution. The short time available makes it a very stressful situation for the priest hearing confessions. More importantly, when hearing confessions between the Masses, the priest has no time to properly prepare for the 1:00PM Mass. A priest must have time to pray and prepare for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Accordingly, as of October 5, we no longer have confessions before the 1:00PM Mass. We will still have confessions available for six days each week. Please see the bulletin and the website for a full listing of confession times. And of course, Father Ghattas and I are available for confession by appointment.

May all of us, by the grace of God, live constantly in a state of grace!

THE STILL SMALL VOICE OF GOD

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Friday around 6:00PM, we returned from our pilgrimage to Greece and the Greek Isles, following in the footsteps of St. Paul. There were so many highlights and blessings over the 11 days that it is difficult to reflect upon them and process them: Athens and the Acropolis; Mars Hill; Corinth; Ephesus; The House of the Virgin Mary; the island of Patmos; the monastery of St. John; the islands of Crete and Santorini; the hanging monasteries of Meteora; and Thessaloniki. It was truly an amazing experience to see the wonders of God's creation and reflect upon St. Paul's journeys and ministry as he was used of God to establish the early Church.

Along the way, of course, we had several tour guides. They equipped us with a Whisper-Jet device for our ears. This enabled them to communicate with us in a low voice as we went through a church, monastery or museum. We could hear the guide's voice, and her voice would not interrupt the other groups who were also going through the site.

And...if you strayed too far from the group, you would receive an automated message in your ear that said: **"You are too far from the group. Please return to the group."** As I listened to this message throughout our pilgrimage, it reminded me that all of us are pilgrims here on earth, each of us hoping that our journey will lead us to heaven to live with Christ forever in the love of the Most Holy Trinity.

It occurred to me that it would be helpful if each of us had a Whisper-Jet device in our ear that would help us on our journey. One that, if we began to fall away from the Church would whisper in our ears: **"You are too far from Holy Mother Church. Please return to the Church."** Wouldn't that be a powerful and helpful reminder?

And yet, if we are honest with ourselves, we know that we do have a system that does that for us. From baptism on, we have the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Holy Trinity, who guides us and speaks to us. "Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with sighs too deep for words. ²⁷And he who searches the hearts of men knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God." (Rom 8:26, 27)

And in early October as we celebrated the Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels, we were reminded that each of us has a personal Guardian Angel who will be our personal guide on our journey to heaven...if we listen.

May we listen carefully for the still small voice of God in our lives!

HOLY BAPTISM

The birth of your child is such a gift! Let St. Mary's parish help you give the gift of new birth through the waters of Holy Baptism. For a child to receive Baptism at St. Mary's, please note that at least one parent must be a practicing Catholic, regularly attend Holy Mass, participate in the life of the parish, and be registered at St. Mary's at least three months prior to requesting the date for Baptism. In this, you become part of our wider parish family! Parents must attend our Baptismal Preparation session prior to the Baptism. The next session is **Sunday, November 16, 2025 at 10:00AM** in Smith Hall. Registration is necessary so that we can prepare for you. Please contact Chris Ascherman at 803.845.0568. Godparents are encouraged to attend a Baptismal Preparation session as well. Since godparents promise to help raise your child in the practice of the Catholic faith, godparents must be practicing Catholics at whatever parish they attend.

HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION

These incredible Sacraments nourish and strengthen us in our Catholic faith so that we can live as "the light of the world" (St. Matthew 5:14). *Please note:* Parents and children must be registered with St. Mary's and faithfully attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. La Voz Apacible y Suave de Dios

Queridos hermanos en Cristo:

El viernes, alrededor de las 18:00, regresamos de nuestra peregrinación a Grecia y las islas griegas, siguiendo los pasos de San Pablo. Hubo tantos momentos destacados y bendiciones durante los 11 días que es difícil reflexionar sobre ellos y procesarlos: Atenas y la Acrópolis; el Areópago; Corinto; Éfeso; la Casa de la Virgen María; la isla de Patmos; el monasterio de San Juan; las islas de Creta y Santorini; los monasterios colgantes de Meteora; y Tesalónica. 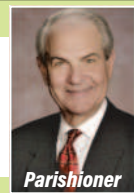
