He is Risen!

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, “is the day the LORD has made!” This is the expression of Psalm 118:24 that we shall be singing throughout Easter time. That phrase is a celebration of our Christian faith. The Father has resurrected Jesus Christ, His beloved Son, in whom He delights, because He has loved us to the point of giving his life for all of us.

May we live this Easter with plenty of joy. Christ has risen, so, let us celebrate it full of joy and love. Death, sin and sadness, have today been defeated by Jesus Christ...and He has opened the doors to a new life, the real life, the life we owe to the grace of the Holy Spirit. Joy should empower our spirits. Christ is our peace and our path forever and ever. Today, He “fully reveals man to man himself and makes his supreme calling clear.” (Gaudium et Spes 22)

The great sign the Gospel gives us today is that Jesus' tomb is empty. We have to look no more among the dead for He who is alive has risen. And his disciples also realize his tomb is empty. They will see him risen later on, experiencing him alive in a joyous faith-filled meeting. An empty tomb and apparitions will be the great signs for the believers' faith. The Gospel says: “Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed.” (John 20:8) Through his faith he realizes that the emptiness, the burial cloths, and the cloth that had covered his head rolled up in a separate place, were all signs that God had been there, signs of the new life. Love can see signs where others cannot, and small signs are enough. “The other disciple whom Jesus loved” (John 20:2) was led by the love he had received from Christ.

The disciples “saw and believed;” this must also be our aim. May we work to renew our paschal faith; that Christ be our Lord in everything we do. May his life revitalize ours and renew the grace of the baptism we have received. The Easter victory should help us become more fervent apostles and disciples, announcing to all our happiness to believe in Christ. May we be a people of hope, that is, hopeful witnesses of His Resurrection!

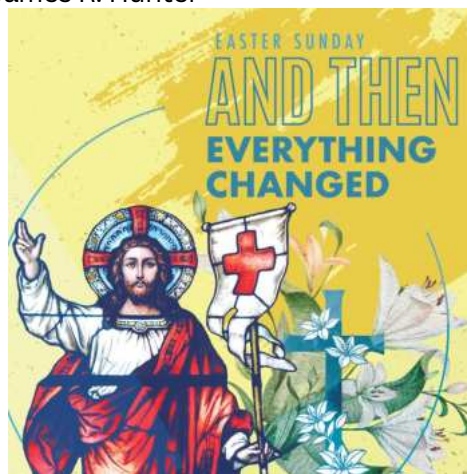

HOLY BAPTISM

The birth of your child is such a gift! Let St. Mary's parish help you give the gift of new birth through the waters of Holy Baptism. For a child to receive Baptism at St. Mary's, please note that at least one parent must be a practicing Catholic, regularly attend Holy Mass, participate in the life of the parish, and be registered at St. Mary's at least three months prior to requesting the date for Baptism. In this, you become part of our wider parish family! Parents must attend our Baptismal Preparation session prior to the Baptism. The next session is **Sunday, May 17, 2026** at 10:00am in Smith Hall. Registration is necessary so that we can prepare for you. Please contact Chris Ascherman at 803.845.0568. Godparents are encouraged to attend a Baptismal preparation class as well. Since godparents promise to help raise your child in the practice of the Catholic faith, godparents must be practicing Catholics at whatever parish they attend.

HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION

These incredible Sacraments nourish and strengthen us in our Catholic faith so that we can live as "the light of the world" (St. Matthew 5:14). Please note: Parents and children must be registered with St. Mary's and faithfully attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. Children who are not enrolled in our Catholic school must attend a minimum of two years of Christian Formation classes and satisfy the attendance policy.

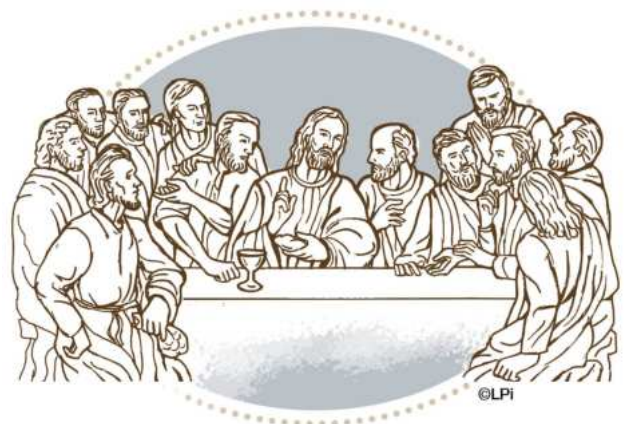

ESPACIO DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

¡Ha resucitado!

Queridos hermanos en Cristo:

Hoy «es el día que hizo el Señor». Esta es la expresión del Salmo 118:24 que cantaremos a lo largo del tiempo pascual. Esa frase es una celebración de nuestra fe cristiana. El Padre ha resucitado a Jesucristo, su Hijo amado, en quien tiene sus complacencias, porque nos ha amado hasta el punto de entregar su vida por todos nosotros.

Vivamos esta Pascua con gran alegría. Cristo ha resucitado; por tanto, celebrémoslo llenos de gozo y amor. La muerte, el pecado y la tristeza han sido hoy derrotados por Jesucristo... y Él ha abierto las puertas a una vida nueva, la vida verdadera, la vida que debemos a la gracia del Espíritu Santo. La alegría debe fortalecer nuestros espíritus. Cristo es nuestra paz y nuestro camino por los siglos de los siglos. Hoy, Él «revela plenamente el hombre al propio hombre y le descubre la sublimidad de su vocación» (Gaudium et Spes 22).

El gran signo que el Evangelio nos ofrece hoy es que la tumba de Jesús está vacía. Ya no tenemos que buscar entre los muertos a Aquel que vive, pues ha resucitado. Y sus discípulos también se dan cuenta de que su tumba está vacía. Más tarde lo verán resucitado, experimentándolo vivo en un encuentro gozoso y lleno de fe. Una tumba vacía y las apariciones serán los grandes signos para la fe de los creyentes. Dice el Evangelio: «Entonces entró también el otro discípulo, el que había llegado primero al sepulcro; vio y creyó» (Juan 20,8). A través de su fe, comprende que el vacío, las vendas y el sudario que había cubierto su cabeza —enrollado en un lugar aparte— eran todos signos de que Dios había estado allí, signos de la vida nueva. El amor puede ver signos donde otros no pueden, y los pequeños signos son suficientes. «El otro discípulo, a quien Jesús amaba» (Juan 20,2), fue guiado por el amor que había recibido de Cristo.

Los discípulos «vieron y creyeron»; este debe ser también nuestro propósito. Trabajemos para renovar nuestra fe pascual; que Cristo sea nuestro Señor en todo cuanto hacemos. Que su vida revitalice la nuestra y renueve la gracia del bautismo que hemos recibido. La victoria de la Pascua debería ayudarnos a convertirnos en apóstoles y discípulos más fervientes, anunciando a todos nuestra dicha de creer en Cristo. ¡Seamos un pueblo de esperanza; es decir, testigos esperanzados de su Resurrección!
