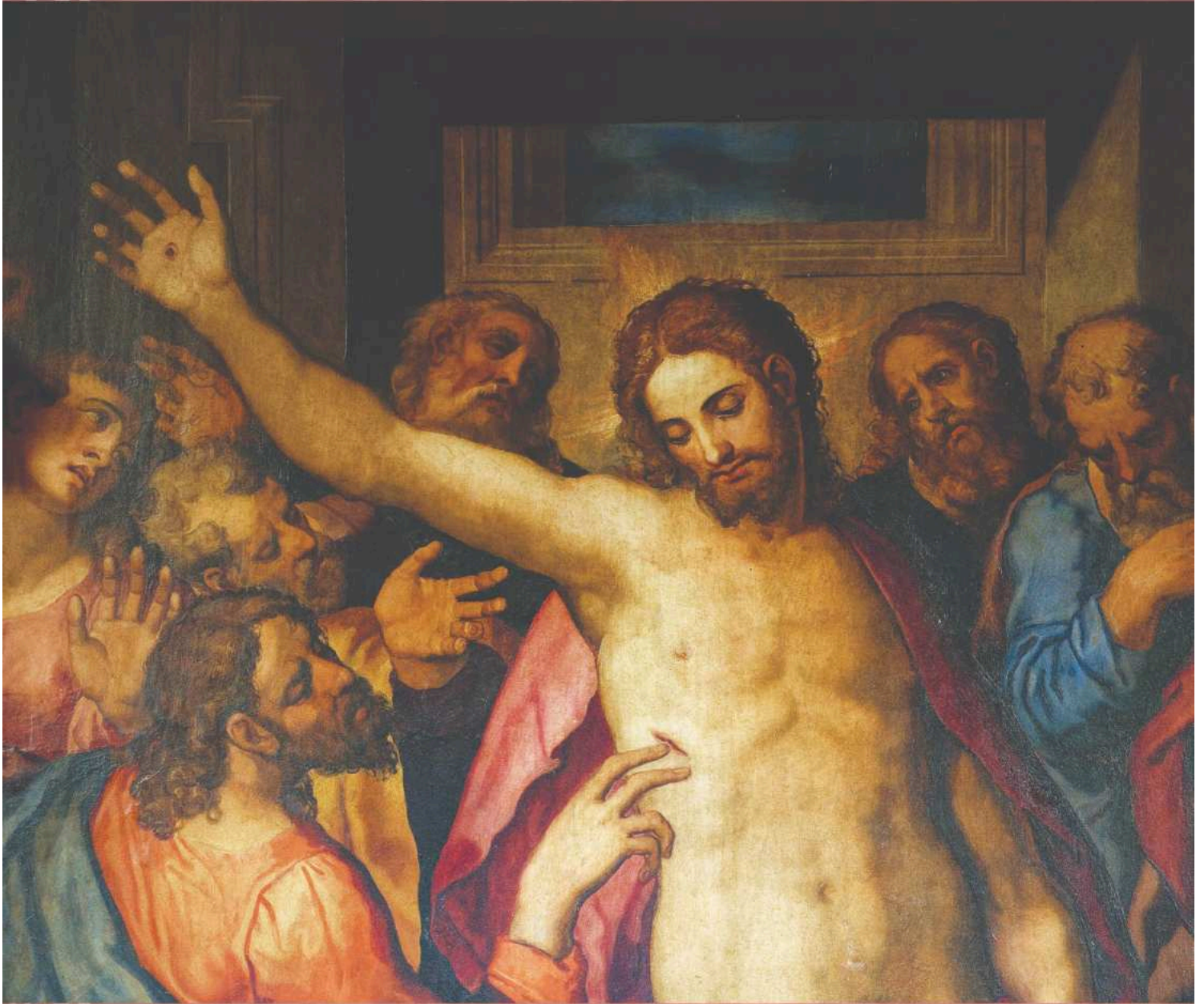

Divine Mercy from our Lord

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, on the Second Sunday of Easter, we complete the octave of this liturgical season, one of the two octaves —together with Christmas— that remain in the liturgy renewed by the Vatican Council II. For eight days, we contemplate the same mystery and try to deepen our understanding of it in the light of the Holy Spirit.

By the design of Pope Saint John Paul II, this Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. It is something that goes far beyond a particular devotion. As explained by the Holy Father in his encyclical *Dives in Misericordia*, Divine Mercy is the loving manifestation of God in a history wounded by sin. In Latin *Misericordia* (which means “mercy”) comes from two words: “miser” (misery) and “cor, cordis” (heart). God puts our unhappy situation due to sin in His Father's heart, which is faithful to His plans.

Jesus Christ, dead and risen, is the supreme manifestation and action of Divine Mercy. “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son” (John 3:16) and sent Him to die so that we might be saved. “To redeem the slave, He sacrificed the Son,” we proclaimed in the *Exsultet* at Easter Vigil. And once resurrected, He made Him a source of salvation for all who believe in Him. Through faith and conversion, we receive the treasure of Divine Mercy.

Holy Mother Church, who wants her children to live the life of the Risen One, commands that we receive Holy Communion and do so in the grace of God — at least during the Easter season. Indeed, the Easter season is the opportune time for paschal fulfillment. It is a good time to confess our sins and to receive the forgiveness of our sins through the faculties that the risen Lord has conferred on his Church, when he said only to the Apostles: “Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them” (John 20:22-23). Thus, we can go to the source of Divine Mercy. May we not hesitate to bring our friends to these sources of life: the Eucharist and Penance. The risen Jesus counts on us to witness for Him.

In this, you become part of our wider parish family! Parents must attend our Baptismal Preparation session prior to the Baptism. The next session is **Sunday, May 17, 2026** at 10:00am in Smith Hall. Registration is necessary so that we can prepare for you. Please contact Chris Ascherman at 803.845.0568. Godparents are encouraged to attend a Baptismal preparation class as well. Since godparents promise to help raise your child in the practice of the Catholic faith, godparents must be practicing Catholics at whatever parish they attend.

HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION

These incredible Sacraments nourish and strengthen us in our Catholic faith so that we can live as "the light of the world" (St. Matthew 5:14). Please note: Parents and children must be registered with St. Mary's and faithfully attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. Children who are not enrolled in our Catholic school must attend a minimum of two years of Christian Formation classes and satisfy the attendance policy.

THE DEPOSIT OF FAITH

Divine Revelation is transmitted to us through Apostolic Tradition. Apostolic Tradition is the communication of Christ's message, beginning with the Apostles, who entrusted all they received from Christ and the Holy to the Church. This Apostolic Tradition is transmitted through sacred Scripture and sacred Tradition. Together, Scripture and Tradition form the one "Deposit of Faith." WHAT IS THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN TRADITION AND SACRED SCRIPTURE? Tradition and sacred Scripture are bound closely together and communicate one with the other. Each of them makes present and fruitful in the Church the mystery of Christ. They flow out of the same divine well spring and together make up one sacred "Deposit of Faith" from which the Church derives her certainty about revelation. (Compendium #14)

ESPACIO DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

La Divina Misericordia de Nuestro Señor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Hoy, en el Segundo Domingo de Pascua, concluimos la octava de este tiempo litúrgico, una de las dos octavas –junto con la de Navidad– que permanecen en la liturgia renovada por el Concilio Vaticano II. Durante ocho días contemplamos el mismo misterio e intentamos profundizar en él a la luz del Espíritu Santo.

Por disposición del Papa San Juan Pablo II, este domingo es el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Es algo que va mucho más allá de una devoción particular. Como explicó el Santo Padre en su encíclica *Dives in Misericordia*, la Divina Misericordia es la manifestación amorosa de Dios en una historia herida por el pecado. En latín, misericordia proviene de dos palabras: miser (misericordia) y cor, cordis (corazón). Dios coloca nuestra situación de miseria causada por el pecado en su corazón de Padre, siempre fiel a sus planes.

Jesucristo, muerto y resucitado, es la manifestación suprema y la acción misma de la Divina Misericordia. “Tanto amó Dios al mundo que entregó a su Hijo único” (Juan 3,16) y lo envió a morir para que fuéramos salvados. “Para rescatar al esclavo, entregó al Hijo”, proclamamos en el Pregón Pascual en la Vigilia. Y una vez resucitado, lo hizo fuente de salvación para todos los que creen en Él. Por la fe y la conversión recibimos el tesoro de la Divina Misericordia.

La Santa Madre Iglesia, que desea que sus hijos vivan la vida del Resucitado, manda que recibamos la Sagrada Comunión en estado de gracia –al menos durante el tiempo de Pascua–. En efecto, el tiempo pascual es el momento oportuno para el cumplimiento pascual. Es un buen tiempo para confesar nuestros pecados y recibir el perdón mediante las facultades que el Señor resucitado confirió a su Iglesia cuando dijo únicamente a los Apóstoles: “Reciban el Espíritu Santo. A quienes les perdonen los pecados, les quedan perdonados” (Juan 20,22-23). Así podemos acudir a la fuente de la Divina Misericordia. No dudemos en llevar a nuestros amigos a estas fuentes de vida: la Eucaristía y la Penitencia. Jesús resucitado cuenta con nosotros para dar testimonio de Él.
