

Annual Financial Report July 2024 – June 30, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With gratitude to God for your generosity, and on behalf of our Finance Council, I am pleased to share with you our 2024–2025 Annual Report, explaining how our financial resources were used during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, and how they have been budgeted for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2025.

We will continue to closely monitor our conservative spending policies so they might reflect what best meets the spiritual needs of our parishioners and perpetual care of our property. A few highlights include replacing the roofs on St Angela Hall and the school Oswald building, remodeled St Angela Hall bathrooms, added security cameras at new church and Ste. Clare chapel, added new electric organ in the old church, replaced old church bell software and wear parts, replaced rectory garage doors, added surge protection to Rectory, Smith Hall, old church and Ste. Clare Chapel, purchased used golf cart and a used pickup truck, new church exterior resealed and caulking and repaired asphalt around campus. We are focusing on preventive maintenance and high priority campus projects and investing wisely towards school and parish programs. Of course, all of this is possible only due to your continued generosity during a time of financial uncertainty for so many.

In the 2024-2025 fiscal year, we exceeded our annual goal of \$2,020,200 by \$46,755.70 in the weekly offertory, and again our wonderful staff and finance council managed our expenses tightly. We remain grateful to our exceptionally faithful volunteers, who make our parish a wonderful place for the of worship God. A special word of thanks goes to you, our parishioners who have continued to generously support both the parish and school during these challenging times, making outstanding things possible at St. Mary Help of Christians parish, our spiritual home.

Our Parish Offertory 2025/2026 request is slightly increased to \$2,129,010. Our costs for utilities, property insurance, etc., have increased dramatically.
