With gratitude to God for your generosity, and on behalf of our School Advisory Council, I am pleased to share with you our 2024–2025 Semiannual Finance Report for St. Mary Help of Christians School. This report explains how our financial resources were used during the past fiscal year and how they have been budgeted for the current year. We will continue to provide these updates at least twice per year, in accordance with Diocese of Charleston guidelines for Catholic Schools.

This year we are very excited to report that we ended the fiscal year with an excess almost \$4,000 better than budget — a remarkable achievement made possible through careful stewardship, strong enrollment, and your ongoing support. Our school community has grown to 240 students, and we are thrilled to welcome so many new families through the opening of our new 3-year-old and 4-year-old preschool programs.

We also continue to give thanks for the many blessings our students experience through the Blessed Carlo Acutis Center. Over the past winter and spring, it has been a joy to see students engaged in hands-on learning opportunities that strengthen both their academic growth and their appreciation for God's creation.

The School Finance Committee, a part of the School Advisory Council, continues to work closely with our principal, Mr. Overstreet, and the Parish Finance Council to monitor spending and support the school's mission. We remain grateful to our dedicated faculty, staff, and faithful volunteers, who together make St. Mary Help of Christians School such a wonderful place for learning and the worship of God. Most of all, we are grateful to you, our parishioners, whose generosity sustains and strengthens our parish and school community.

Please continue to keep our students, faculty, and families in your prayers, as we also keep you in ours.
